SERBIA 2026

Serbia has one of the most liberal visa policies in Europe, thus enabling delegates from both EU and non-EU countries to attend the Annual Meeting 2026 without any visa procedure issues and additional costs.

CITIZENS OF THE FOLLOWING COUNTRIES DO NOT NEED TO OBTAIN VISAS

Citizens of the following may enter the Republic of Serbia using their passports or ID cards and stay up to 90 days: European Union countries, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Iceland, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Norway, and Switzerland.

With a valid passport, the visa-free regime applies to citizens of the following countries, among others, with stay durations varying by country: Andorra, Argentina, Armenia, Australia, Azerbaijan, Bahrain, Belarus, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China-PR, Colombia, Costa Rica, Georgia, Israel, Japan, Kazakhstan, Mexico, Moldova, New Zealand, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Republic of Korea, Russian Federation, Seychelles, Singapore, Turkey, Ukraine, UAE, UK, United States of America, Uruguay, Venezuela, and Vatican – Holy See.

Nationals provided they are holding diplomatic and official passports, or ordinary passports indicating they are traveling on business: Algeria, Cuba, DPR Korea, Ecuador, Egypt, Guinea, Iran, Kuwait, Laos, Lebanon, Morocco, Pakistan, Vietnam.

Nationals holding a valid Schengen, UK, and other EU Member States' visa, or a visa of the United States of America, can enter Serbia without any additional visa procedures.

VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR COUNTRIES NOT LISTED ABOVE

1. Valid Passport
2. Supporting documentation:
 - a letter of invitation (verified by the appropriate Serbian authority)
 - an invitation from a company for a business visit
 - a receipt or authorized tourist company certifying that the travel arrangement has been paid (letter of credit or other payment receipts)
3. Return ticket
4. Proof of sufficient funds in hard currency
5. Health Insurance
6. Completed visa application, photo and visa fee
